The Local Labour Market

Labour market intelligence from 2018 shows that the culture, tourism and leisure sector is a growing key job sector within Tees Valley. There are over 32,100 residents of the Tees Valley currently employed in this sector. There are over 14,000 extra jobs predicted in the Creative, Tourism and Leisure sector between now and 2024. A qualification based in travel and tourism would support students to accessing these vacancies as it would give students an understanding of the aims of many organisations and the skills they would likely be looking for in their workforce. A level 2 qualification in Travel and Tourism will provide students with a grounding of these skills to enable them to continue to develop them as they get older.
